MEET FEES:

All meet fees are calculated for the whole season and divided into **8 payments due July 16th – February 16th**.

All team members are required to have an auto-debit form on file. All team and meet fees are non-refundable. All meets are considered mandatory (unless extenuating circumstances arise).

Annual Team Fee is due by April 30th and includes: Meet Fees, Coaching Fees, Coaching Professional Development, End of Season Celebration.

Compulsory (Levels 3 - 5 & Excel)

Annual Team Fee: \$170 | *Late fee of \$100 may be applied after April 30th*
Meet Fees: 8 payment of \$77 Includes 4 Required Meets & State

Optional (Levels 6 - 10)

Annual Team Fee: \$230 | *Late fee of \$100 may be applied after April 30th*
Meet Fees*: 8 payments of \$162 Includes 5 Required Meets & State

* USAG Meet Fees may be subject to a slight increase based on USAG fee increases. They include 4 USAG Meets, 1 NGA Meet, and 1 Virtual Meet, and State Meet. Regional and National meet fees will be determined later in the season and **paid separately for those that qualify (Estimate \$300 - \$1,500).**

Clothing:

We are using the same leotard as last season. Price will be \$149 for those needing one. These will be paid for and sized in the late summer. Other mandatory items will be announced during the summer/fall (practice leotard, capri pant, slides, back pack, etc..)

Code of Conduct and General Regulations:

These regulations apply to parents, spectators, and the gymnasts:

Act professional at all times, at all locations. You will receive one warning from the director and then you will be removed from the program.

As a member of the Royals, you will show the utmost respect to teammates, visitors, coaches, staff, family members, and competitors.

Show commitment and loyalty towards the team and its members. Team unity is crucial.

Demonstrate a positive attitude, and a genuine desire to strive for excellence.

Bullying, profanity, abusive language, and inappropriate photos or behavior are not allowed. This includes Tik Tok, Facebook, Instagram, SnapChat, texts etc. ANYONE violating this policy may be immediately removed by the director. **This is a ZERO tolerance area. (Think twice before you post)**

Negative attitudes and disrespecting coaches and/or team members whether in person or online will not be tolerated and will result in immediate discipline and potential dismissal.

Additional misconduct subject to disciplinary actions or dismissal includes but is not limited to the following: any conduct which constitutes a danger to any person's health, safety, or person's well-being, such as physical abuse or threat of abuse; any behavior which is obscene, lewd, indecent, violent, excessively noisy, disorderly, or anything that unreasonably disturbs other groups or individuals.

During practice there is NO food, soft drinks, cell phones, or gum chewing at any time. Water bottles with a closable lid are the only authorized drinks during practice.

When viewing practices, please do not coach/communicate to your child through the window.

Parental/Guardian Obligations:

Responsible for bringing your gymnast to practices, performances, and events on time unless an arrangement with the director has been made prior to the event. Excessive absences will be a factor in determining your child's placement within the Royals training groups.

Hotel & travel arrangements (if desired) are the responsibility of the parents - this includes travel costs such as food, hotel expenses, and souvenirs.

Responsible for attending parent meetings.

Responsible for assisting coaches in the promotion of positive reinforcement. Please emphasize a positive attitude with your athlete at all times.
